The County of Riverside will construct a series of sidewalks along streets in Carver Tract, an unincorporated area of Riverside County between Indio and Coachella. The Carver Tract Sidewalk Safety Improvement Project is located within Van Buren Street, Avenue 48, Manila Avenue, and Luzon Street.

IMPROVEMENTS

Major improvements include the installation of new sidewalks along,

- South side of Leyte Ave
- North side of Corregidor Ave
- North side of Lingayen Ave
- West side of Luzon St

The project will also reconstruct sections of the roadway, install a new storm drain with underground retention system, new concrete curb & gutters, driveway/alley approaches, and mailboxes along new proposed concrete sidewalk.

PROJECT BENEFITS

The sidewalks will improve pedestrian access to local community facilities and services such as Martin Van Buren Elementary School, Coachella Valley Rescue Mission, Fred Young Farm Labor Center and Rancho Las Flores Park.

Construction Cost: \$1.515 million

Funding: Senate Bill 821 Bicycle, Facilities Funding Program and Gas Tax

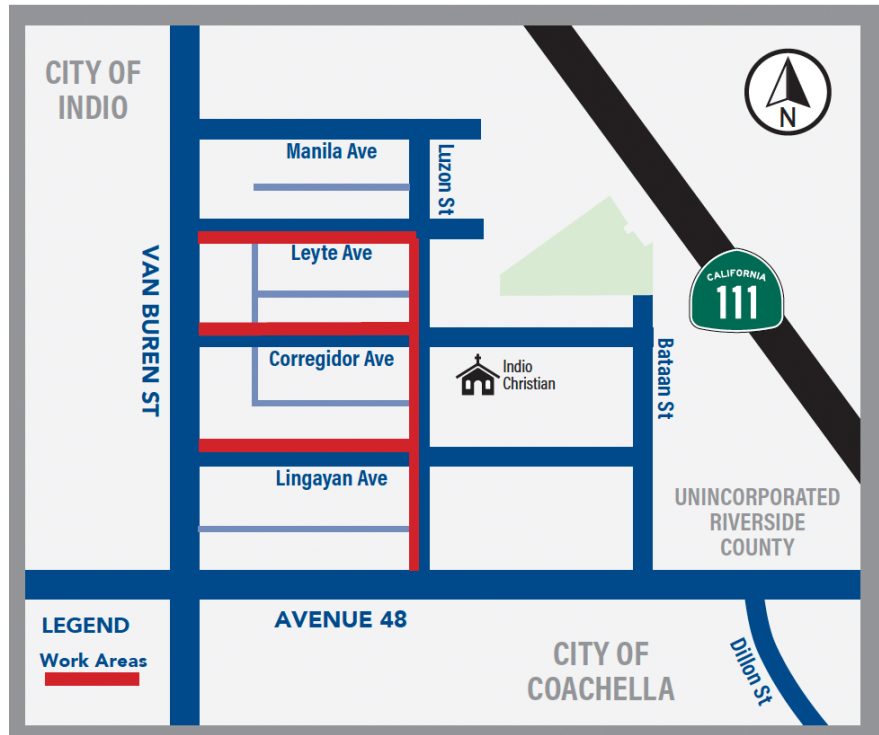
Schedule: Spring 2022 through Summer 2022 (Approximately 4 months)
