Roadway Rehabilitation Project



LINCOLN STREET CONSTRUCTION To begin the week of October 17, 2022

The County of Riverside Transportation Department will rehabilitate Lincoln Street from Magnolia Avenue to Indiana Avenue. The eight-week project will:

- Relocate street lamps in the project right of way.
- Reconstruct damaged curb and gutter.
- Reconstruct cross gutters at Lincoln Street and Harlow Avenue.
- Complete ADA compliant sidewalk improvements at the intersections of Lincoln Street with Indiana Avenue, Camino San Benito Drive and at Harlow Avenue.
- Remove existing roadway pavement on Lincoln Street.
- Repave and restripe Lincoln Street.
- Install roadway signs.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Lincoln Street will remain OPEN in both directions during construction. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists through the construction zone. Expect delays during construction; please use alternate routes.



Business access will remain open during construction. Please follow traffic control signs to safely access business centers.




Please reduce speed and travel with caution through the construction zone.



Construction crews started with utility relocation work to be followed by concrete work including cross gutters, curb and gutter improvements, and ADA ramp improvements. Next, crews will remove pavement and repave Lincoln Street, followed by street striping and signage installation.
