



I-15/Limonite Avenue Interchange Project

FACT SHEET

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The I-15/Limonite Ave interchange ramp intersections currently operate at an acceptable level of service (LOS). Based on the most recent update of the Riverside County General Plan, the cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley plan to add a substantial number of residences and businesses in the coming years, which is anticipated to result in substantial traffic. By the year 2040, the ramp intersections at the I-15/Limonite Avenue interchange will have insufficient capacity to accommodate the forecasted traffic demand. The improvements to the I-15/Limonite Ave Interchange are needed to reduce traffic congestion at the I-15/Limonite Ave interchange.

PROPOSED PROJECT FEATURES

- A new 8-lane overcrossing (including three through lanes and one turn lane in each direction) plus bike lanes, shoulder, and sidewalk.
- Widening of Limonite to four lanes in each direction between Hamner Avenue and Wineville Avenue.
- Two new loop on-ramps and widened direct on- and off-ramps.

PROJECT FUNDING

The County currently has funding for project approval, design, and right of way acquisition. Funding sources are currently being identified for construction of the project.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Circulate Draft Environmental Document—July/August 2015
- Environmental Document Approval—February 2016
- Project Approval—March 2016
- Begin Construction—April 2017
