PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

PHASE 1

COST: \$2.4 MILLION

SCOPE: Phase 1 includes pavement rehabilitation and safety improvements.

PHASE 2

COST: \$6.6 MILLION

SCOPE: Phase 2 will rehabilitate the pavement, widen the shoulders and realign several curves along Gilman Springs Road and add a southbound passing lane south of Alessandro Blvd.

PHASE 3

COST: \$2.5 MILLION

SCOPE: Phase 3 includes the curve realignment along Gilman Springs Road north of Soboba Road.

PHASE 4

COST: \$8.0 MILLION

SCOPE: Phase 4 will include drainage improvements, shoulder widening and slope adjustments

PHASE 5

COST: TO BE DETERMINED

SCOPE: Phase 5 will include traffic signal improvements at the SR-79 northbound and southbound ramps.

PHASE 6

COST: TO BE DETERMINED

SCOPE: Phase 6 proposed improvements will include construction of passing lanes in the north bound direction between Jack Rabbit Trail and SR-79.
