Nighttime work continues during the week with 55-hour continuous weekend work planned. Please reduce speed in the construction zone.

Nighttime Work

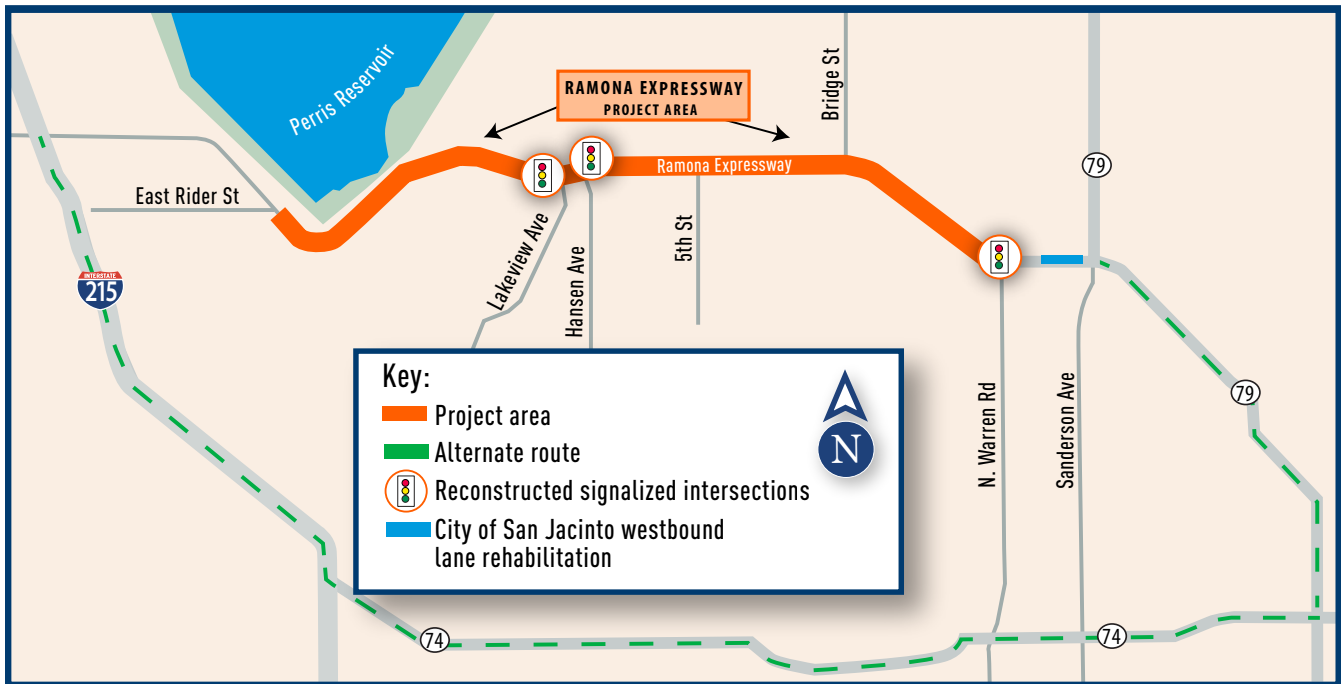
From Wednesday, July 7, through Sunday, July 16, during nighttime work from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., crews will be paving a rubberized asphalt layer on Ramona Expressway from Rider to 5th streets. No paving will occur in the intersections.

- Expect single lane closures with one lane open and flaggers to assist vehicles through the work zone.
- Please plan for delays.

Weekend day and night work

From Friday, July 9 at 8 p.m., through Monday morning, July 12 at 5 a.m., crews will be excavating the roadway, paving the base layer and paving the final asphalt cap on the outside westbound lane of Ramona Expressway from Warren to Sanderson roads in the city of San Jacinto.

- Please plan for delays and uneven roadway.
- Flaggers will be assisting vehicles through the construction zone.
